
A Sonos System cannot access Metropics Radio directly. These instructions are for a workaround where the TuneIn music streaming service is used as an intermediary.

The Sonos application on your computer can see two versions of TuneIn. The old version has a black and white icon and is called **TuneIn**. The new version has a black and turquoise icon and is called **TuneIn (New)**. To use the Sonos app on your computer to add Metropics Radio to your Sonos System you have to use the old version of TuneIn.

A) Add TuneIn to Sonos using your Computer

1. Open the **Sonos** app on your Computer.
2. Click on the **Manage** menu, then click on **Service Settings**.
3. On the **Service Settings** screen, click on the **+** to add a new service.
4. On the **Add a Service** screen, click on **TuneIn** (not TuneIn (New)), then on **Next**.
5. On the **Add TuneIn** screen, click on **Set up TuneIn**.
6. On the **Setup Complete** screen, click on **Done**.
7. Back on the **Service Settings** screen, you can see that **TuneIn** has been added. **TuneIn (New)** may also be there. It is okay to have both versions of Tunein.
8. Close the **Service Settings** screen.

B) Add Metropics Radio to Sonos using your Computer

1. Open the **Sonos** app on your Computer.
2. Click on the **Manage** menu, then click on **Add Radio Station**.
3. On the **Add Radio Station** screen, type the following into the **Streaming URL** field <http://streaming.live365.com/a56368?l> (the last character is a lower case L)
4. Enter **Metropics Radio** into the **Station Name** field, then click **OK**.
5. **Metropics Radio** is now added to **My Radio Stations** under **Tuneln**.
